The Galmont Hotel recognise that our business has an important role to play in protecting and enhancing the environment for the future generations and to help secure the long-term sustainability of the Tourism industry. It is our priority to encourage our customers, suppliers, and all business associations to do the same.

We currently practice sound environmental practise across our entire operation and fully comply with all relevant legislations. We produce annual sustainability plan which sets outs our objectives, targets, and planned actions.

Our goal is to be responsible hotel operators, by reducing our carbon footprint while improving the guest experience, act in the highest environmental interest of all our stakeholders.

The Management and staff of the Galmont Hotel are committed to continue our focus on the following areas:

- To minimise our waste and reduce our water and energy consumption where possible.
- To help increase awareness with regards to protecting the environment and to support our staff, customers, and suppliers in doing so.
- To provide all employees with the training and resources required to meet these green objectives.
- To communicate our policies and practise to all stakeholders
- To monitor and record our environmental impacts on a regular basis and to monitor our performance against our policies, objective sand targets.

Results from 2024.

Our goal was to reduce our total energy by 10% in 2024 based on rooms sold. We achieved a 6.05% saving in electricity, and 13.31% saving in gas, additionally we have a recycling rate of 85% which means that less than 15% of our waste goes to landfill.

Our Sustainability focus for 2025.

1. Energy Conservation

We strive to continue our efforts by reducing our carbon footprint. We plan to reduce our Gas consumption by 20% and our Electricity by 10% per room sold.

2. Water conservation

We also have a goal to reduce our water consumption by 7.5 % in 2025.

3. Waste Management

To ensure no more than 15% of our waste goes to landfill.

4. Sustainable procurement and product usage

To continue to use locally produced produce from our local Artisan suppliers and give preference to suppliers with an active environmental policy.

5. Community Social Responsibility

To communicate our performance and achievement through the hotel website and to facilitate/ promote the use of greener transport.

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
